All children need a weatherproof outdoor coat, preferably with a hood.

In the winter months we request that during snowy conditions your child is dressed suitably for the playground – this includes having a second pair of shoes to be worn outside, such as Wellingtons; tracksuit bottoms / waterproof trousers; gloves, hat and scarf. You may wish to send them in with spare socks or tights.

In summer months we insist that all children come to school with a hat and are wearing sunscreen.

Jewellery, other than stud earrings and watches (when children are able to tell the time), is not permitted in School. Children with long hair must have it tied back. Make-up, nail varnish and body art are not permitted.
