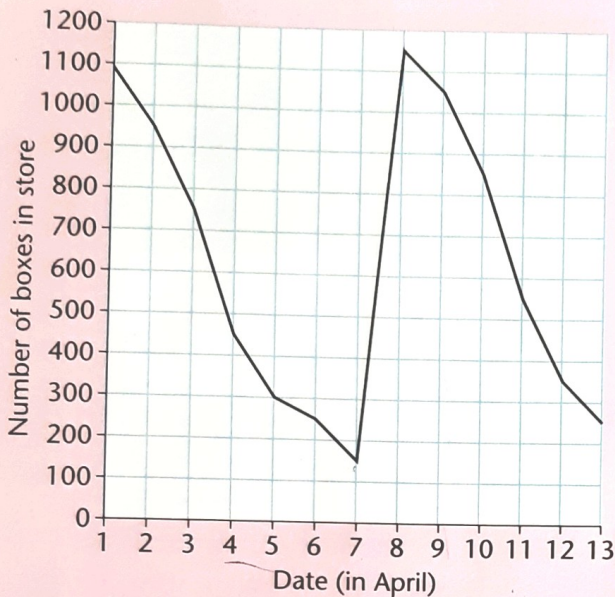

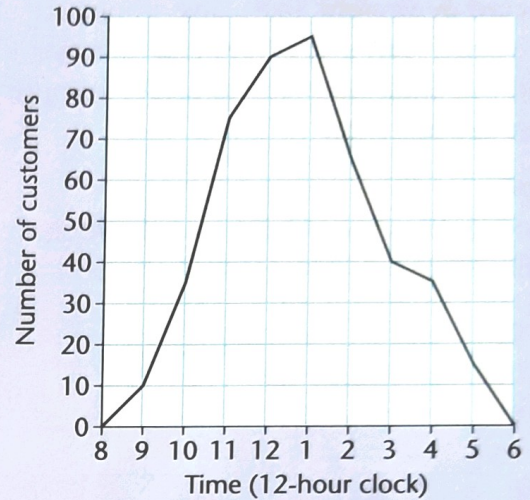
This graph shows the number of boxes of cornflakes a supermarket has in stock recorded each morning before the store opens.

- How many fewer customers were in the shop at 9 am than 10 am?
- Estimate the number of customers in the shop at:
 - 10.30 am
 - 1.30 pm?
- In which hour was there:
 - the largest rise in customers
 - the largest fall in customers?
- Between 11 am and noon 117 customers entered the shop. How many left?
- Between 3 pm and 4 pm 56 customers left the shop. How many entered?
