

Dear Parents,

Following this evening's announcement I can confirm that the school will be closed with immediate effect for all children other than those whose parents are key workers or deemed vulnerable.

If you emailed the office this evening to say that you are a key worker we will be expecting your child in school tomorrow. Please continue to use the turning circle and observe the drop off and collection times that were in place last term.

For those children not in school there will be remote learning in place on google classroom from tomorrow morning. Teachers will also be providing google meet sessions but more information about that will follow tomorrow.

The children in school will be being supervised by our learning support assistants and will also be completing the work set on google classroom.

I apologise for the late arrival of this email but the Teachers2Parents email system was suspended to add to the challenges of the day, I suspect it is not set up for so many schools in the country to try and use it at the same time!

Please do not hesitate to contact the school if we can be of any help. Remember the older children are all very good at using google classroom independently and may be able to help younger siblings. There are also instructions on the school website for how to access it. We have had a website makeover which I wasn't going to reveal until it was completely ready but it is a useful place to find how to use google classroom instructions before ringing the office!
