Homework routine update:

Sprites: weekly work not set, homework is suggested for Sprites children, but they will benefit from practice. Phonics sheets to reinforce sounds and tricky words after each set. Reading books are changed 3 times a week..

Phoenix: the homework folder containing a piece of Maths, English, spellings and times tables will be given out on Friday and is due back Thursday, but you are most welcome to return it sooner. Reading books are changed daily (or when finished). Reading records are checked daily.

Pegasus: English and Maths homework is set on Wednesday on the VLE and is due in on Monday. Reading records are checked every Monday with an expectation of records showing reading at least 5 times a week. Spellings are set on Tuesday and tested the following Tuesday spelling sentences to be written in the spelling book. Times tables practice grids are given out on Mondays.

Griffin: All homework is set on Thursday and due on Tuesday. English, Maths, spellings are on the VLE and need to be completed in appropriate homework books. Times tables practice grids are also available on the VLE. Reading records are collected on Mondays with an expectation of records showing reading at least 5 times a week.

World Book Day at Chenies – Wednesday, 1st March 2017 – "Get Caught Reading":

Remember we will be celebrating World Book Day next Wednesday, 1st March. We would like photographic evidence of children reading their books in interesting ways or places. In addition they will be asked to come dressed as a character from one of their favourite books - NOT FILMS.
