Maths Whizz

A reminder that children in Years 2-6 should complete 30 minutes on maths whizz each week – this includes during the holidays. The Whizz Winter Adventure has gone live. This is designed to keep children motivated with learning, even when they're not at school. It contains 12 themed activities, of which 6 are game-style activities and 6 are 'Around the World' festivities quizzes. While the Winter Adventure is live, every 30 credits earned results in a star. Each Winter Adventure activity costs two stars and each quiz costs one star. A puzzle piece of a winter scene is unlocked every time an activity is completed. Once every puzzle piece is revealed, the scene comes alive!
