# **INDIVIDUAL CLASS NEWS**

### Sprites:

<u>Phonics</u>: Next week the children will continue to work through Phase 2 and Phase 3 sounds focusing on segmenting and blending to read/write new words across all areas of learning. The key sounds that we will be consolidating are the *diagraphs* – <u>ck</u> <u>II</u> <u>ff</u> <u>ss</u> <u>zz</u>. These sounds are usually found in the middle or the end of a word e.g. <u>duck</u> <u>buzzing</u>. Our tricky word focus is <u>he</u>, <u>she</u>, <u>we</u>, <u>& be</u>. We will continue to reinforce *I*, <u>to</u>, <u>go</u>, <u>no</u> <u>& the</u>.

<u>Literacy:</u> We are learning about stringing a sentence together. The children are given a picture or a set of cards as a prompt *e.g. a cat sitting on a mat*. They count the number of words (six) and write one word at a time, saying each word out aloud to help them hear the sounds. The children are encouraged to use sound mats to identify sounds and write key words.

<u>Maths:</u> We will be continuing to consolidate learning the names of 3D shapes (sphere, cylinder, cube and cone).

<u>Topic:</u> We will be introducing our new topic 'Food Creations'. This will start with our visit to Pizza Express on Tuesday 29<sup>th</sup> January, after which we will start looking at recipes and building on our culinary skills.

# Phoenix

In Phoenix class this week during Literacy we will be thinking about information texts and looking closely at how to improve our sentence writing.

In Maths we will be learning about money and continuing to learn times tables, focusing on multiples of 5 and ten.

Our area of learning this week in topic is <u>Things That Grow</u>. We will be looking at plants in the local area, learning about what we need to do to help them grow healthily.

# **Pegasus**

Next week in English we will be aiming to finish reading the book "Ottoline and the Yellow Cat" by Chris Riddell. The children will be continuing to read and discuss the book, using inference to create predictions of what may happen, with the aim to use the book as inspiration for writing their own mystery story.

In maths we are going to start looking at decimal numbers, and their relation to fractions.

Pegasus will continue learning about the Tudors. They will be looking into the lives of people during the Tudor times. In science we are going to continue experimenting with sounds. The children will be given resources to make "string telephones" and they will be challenged to come up with an investigation that they could run independently.

#### Griffin

#### **English**

Next week we will be focussing on improving our grammar skills and using these within our independent writing. The children will be producing both fiction and non-fiction pieces across the week. We are hoping, after our lessons, that they will be more efficiently able to demonstrate their use of: adverbials, modal verbs, relative pronouns and word classes.

#### Maths

We will begin our maths unit about fractions next week. The children will be securing their knowledge and understanding of equivalent fractions, simplifying fractions as well as adding and subtracting fractions. We will also continue with our weekly times tables test. The children are getting better and a few are so close to reaching their next goal - so keep practising!

#### Topic

In topic we're going to continue looking at and writing about the similarities and differences between the polar regions. As part of our science work, we are hoping to go into the woods to collect leaves and investigate trees in order to classify these ahead of producing botanical drawings in the coming weeks. Please ensure that your child has a warm coat and suitable footwear in order to take part in the session.
