Summary of main barriers to educational achievement faced by eligible pupils:

- Low prior attainment
- Mobility: pupils changing schools mid-year or key stage
- Previous poor attendance

Aims:

- to accelerate progress in reading (including phonics), writing and maths
- to increase the numbers of pupils at age-related expectations
- to improve attendance and learning behaviour
- to improve social and emotional skills
- improve opportunities to develop physical, musical and artistic skills

Next steps from 2015-16

- continue to monitor school attendance closely
- additional phonics training for TAs
- additional guided group training for TAs
- continue to monitor use of interventions
- additional training for CTs and TAs in breaking learning down/extending learning through marking & feedback
- Ensure Maths vocabulary is explicit and plan for creativity in maths planning and lessons
- Training in problem solving in Maths for CTs

The impact of Pupil Premium spending will be measured by pupil voice, parent voice, assessment data, evidence of progress in books, evidence of progress during lesson observations and learning walks.

The school's Pupil Premium strategy will be reviewed in April 2017.
