Stage 2 – Level Two	<ul> <li>Lying</li> <li>Interrupting an adult</li> <li>Unauthorised use of school property</li> <li>Refusal to follow instructions</li> <li>Name calling/teasing</li> <li>Spitting</li> <li>Refusal to say sorry after accidentally hurting someone</li> <li>Talking behind people's backs</li> <li>Retaliation</li> <li>Eating/chewing in class</li> <li>Continuing with level 1 behaviours</li> </ul>	<ul> <li>Speak to the child</li> <li>Discuss consequences of behaviour</li> <li>Separate child from situation or other children</li> <li>If a child persists with these types of behaviours then they are given three further warnings. These must be clear and recorded on the child's chart as dots.</li> </ul>	<ul> <li>Managed by staff member and teacher informed</li> <li>Separate from class or group for a while</li> <li>Write a letter of apology or apologise verbally</li> <li>Complete unfinished work in own time e.g. playtime</li> <li>Possible temporary withdrawal of a privilege</li> <li>Children in Reception will be given a 10 minute time in lesson.</li> <li>A child on Level 2 will be required to attend the behaviour reflection room at lunch time- supervised by Mr Hook.</li> <li>KS1 = 10 minutes</li> <li>KS2 = 20 minutes</li> <li>If a child receives three further warnings then they move to level 3</li> </ul>

Stage 3 – Level Three	<ul> <li>Discriminative comments including racism</li> <li>Throwing objects with intent</li> <li>Ignoring an adult</li> <li>Swearing</li> <li>Stealing</li> <li>Leaving the class without permission</li> <li>Abuse of power</li> <li>Showing disrespect to a member of staff</li> <li>Throwing food</li> </ul>	<ul> <li>Possible involvement of parents</li> <li>Possible involvement of SLT and/or a Behaviour Support Team</li> <li>In the case of a racial incident, the appropriate racial incident form will be completed and submitted to the LA</li> <li>A child can move directly to level 3 for demonstrating these behaviours.</li> <li>If a child persists with level 1 &amp; 2 behaviours then they are given three further warnings. These must be clear and recorded on the child's chart as dots.</li> </ul>	<ul> <li>Managed by Class teacher</li> <li>Possible exclusion from classroom for a given amount of time</li> <li>Possible involvement of parent within school e.g. working with their child</li> <li>Possible lunchtime exclusion for a specified period</li> <li>Consider putting in place an Individual Behaviour Plan</li> <li>Possible placing on SEN register at School Action or School Action Plus for emotional and behavioural difficulties</li> <li>Children in Reception will be given a 15 minute time in lesson.</li> <li>A child on Level 3 will be required to attend the behaviour reflection room at lunch time- supervised by Mr Hook.</li> <li>KS1 = 15 minutes</li> <li>KS2 = 30 minutes</li> </ul>

Stage 4 – Level Four	<ul> <li>Repeatedly leaving the classroom without permission</li> <li>Leaving school grounds (or attempting to) without permission</li> <li>Throwing large or dangerous objects</li> <li>Fighting and intentional physical harm to other children</li> <li>Persistent bullying, including racial harassment</li> <li>Serious challenges to authority</li> <li>Verbal abuse of any member of staff</li> <li>Vandalism</li> <li>Stealing</li> </ul>	<ul> <li>Parents informed</li> <li>Immediate removal of offender from scene</li> <li>Immediate involvement of Headteacher</li> <li>Record of incident</li> <li>Involvement of Behaviour Support Team</li> </ul>	<ul> <li>Managed by SLT</li> <li>Telephone parents and meet with them as soon as possible</li> <li>Possible lunchtime exclusion for behaviour during lunch break</li> <li>Possible fixed term exclusion</li> <li>Pastoral support programme considered</li> </ul>
