Dear Parents and Carers

Wednesday afternoon in Griffin was probably the best two hours of school I've ever had the good fortune to experience. As part of their WWII topic, Griffin were visited by Jimmy James, a 94 year old WWII veteran. Jimmy flew in the RAF and in September 1944 he was shot down and captured in Rimini, Italy. He spoke his story to the children: signing up, training, flying missions, capture, prison in Poland, prisoner march, prison in Berlin, escape and freedom. The clarity of his memory was remarkable, his powerful description of these events had the children (and adults) transfixed. The children asked excellent questions and listened with intense concentration; I am sure this will inspire wonderful work as they progress through the topic.

As you may know, with some parent volunteer help, next Wednesday we are reorganising the library; rescanning all the books and scanning in the new books our fabulous PTA purchased, which have all been delivered. The teachers are also focusing on reading with a particular focus on reading records. We expect that our children will be heard reading at home at least five times during the week, this vital practice allows children to develop their reading skills, be that new phonic sounds or developing greater understanding of inference and deduction. Your support in this critical area of our children's development is greatly appreciated.

World Book day is on Thursday 1st March and we will celebrate that day as a key part of the whole week of celebrating reading. More details will follow.

We said goodbye and thank you to our lovely Sprites TA, Mrs Collins, on Thursday—we wish her all the best for the future.


Parents @ Chenies School (PTA):
