Look back at your plan

Is there anything you have thought about that you would like to change or add?

Is there anything you would like to check in the text before you start writing?

Once you have read through and are happy with your plan, you can start writing.

Remember

- Refer back to your plan often
- Use resources to help you eg your writing essentials booklet if you have it, a thesaurus, a dictionary
- Think about your sentences before you write – do they make sense?
- When you have finished – read it back aloud.
- Edit and improve – up level vocabulary, up level punctuation, can you change any grammatical devices eg relative clause, passive voice, different conjunctions?
- Now read your writing aloud to someone else
- Be proud of your work
