Pegasus Trip to Metro Bank - Thursday 17th January 2019

The children in Pegasus Class have been working with visitors from Metro Bank to learn about banking. Over a number of sessions the children have learnt about the key features of a bank, the benefits of saving and interest, budgeting and the difference between "wants" and "needs". During these sessions the children discussed and debated the benefits and drawbacks of using banks and banking systems, drew up a personal saving plan to achieve a goal and applied their learning to solve simple money problems.

To follow up these sessions the children will be visiting Metro Bank in High Wycombe on Thursday 17th January 2019 in the afternoon. They will be given a tour of the bank and will learn about the roles and responsibilities within different areas. They will be get a chance to go into the vault and be shown how the ATM and Magic Money Machines work. The visit will last approximately one hour. The children will leave school straight after lunch and will return to school by **3.30pm**.

A voluntary donation of £6.70 per child is requested towards the cost of the transport and insurance. No child will be refused from going on the outing through financial hardship. Please contact the office if you need assistance.
