Dear Parent / Carer

As you may be aware, the funding provided by the Government does not fully cover the cost of providing Key Stage 1 school meals; therefore the school is providing parents with the opportunity to make a donation to help address this shortfall.

We would like to thank all those Key Stage 1 parents who have already given donations towards the school meals.

If you wish to make a donation or add to a previous donation towards the cost of providing Key Stage 1 school meals, there is a payment item on ParentPay '50p meal donation for KS1' to allow you to pay a donation amount of your choosing, up to a maximum of £100. The item will be open for the complete academic year and can be paid in instalments of your choosing, each half term is approximately £17. This offers a simplified way to pay the 50p donation towards the daily school meal provision.
