Matters Arising

An update on Classlist and its features was given. Currently using it for events and announcements but also plans to use the marketplace feature in future for uniform etc. Also talked through how you can edit notification and privacy settings. There are now 50 parents now on Classlist with the Class Reps following up with any who haven't yet joined. Mel Jemmet provided some positive feedback on the network so far from the year 5s.

Event costs may go up a small amount as a consequence of using Classlist but it is thought that our events are still very well-priced and the amount of time it saves the office having to collect money and paper forms warrants this.

It was explained that we fundraise and the school chooses what we spend the money on. We do not buy things for the school that we think they want, nor do we collect donations of items to pass to the school (unless it's cash). When we agree on an item for the school, they present us with a quote and we need 3 comparable quotes before agreeing the amount.

The school like us to assist in funding a combination of both larger and smaller projects. Lately most have been smaller: Library software licence, Christmas craft, the pantomime workshop.

Mrs Powell presented her wish list which includes:

Mrs Sahotay confirmed that we can get all the uniform stock out for sale when the summer Reception inductions take place as there are a lot of smaller sizes available.
